-you should have a disaster supply kit in a designated place, kit should have supplies for up to two weeks.

-you should have supplies for your car also, such as jumper cables, blanket, first aid kit, etc.

- Food safety & sanitation rules:
 - alternative cooking sources
 - managing food without power
 - 1 gallon of water per person for 3 days

- Shelter in Place tips:
 - preferably stay in a room without windows
 - develop a form of communication plan with family members (meeting place, etc)
 - develop an evacuation plan

-church began in 1906

-Church was located on 1st street until a fire, then relocated to McGonagle.

-average: 180-200 people attend service
